

Brown bear, Brown bear, What do you see? Storytelling Tips and Learning Tools

Before narration:

- Introduce this story as a book with many colorful animals

Storytelling:

- When you ask, “Brown bear, brown bear, what do you see?” show the children the next page and ask the children to guess the animal’s name. Then read out from the book. Do this for all pages

Extended activities:

- You can use a flannel board to introduce the different animals in the book. Cut out the different animal shapes and place them one at a time on the board as you read the book
- With each animal you introduce, you could make the sound the animal makes. Neigh like the horse, quack like the duck, etc.
- Visit a farm or petting zoo where the children can see the different animals
