

## From Head to Toe: Storytelling Tips and Learning Tools

---

### **Before narration:**

- Introduce this story as a book that shows what animals can do

### **Storytelling:**

- Enact the story: Make the child stand on the floor as you read the first few lines of each page. For ex., I'm a camel and I bend my knees. Can you do it?  
Make/teach the child to bend her knees and once the child does it, cheer the kid saying, "(Child's name) can do it!"  
This really encourages and motivates the child. They have lots of fun imitating the animals in the book. They also have lots of fun when an adult shows them how to do certain things animals do.

### **Extended activities:**

- If the children are interested, you could add more animals and keep going on longer
